Episcopal High School March Library Renovation Alexandria, VA

- APM has completed 7 projects with Episcopal High School (Phase II Campus Improvements, Science Building, Kitchen Renovations, Robertson Dorm Conversion, Centennial Gym Addition and Renovations, Goodman Squash Center, and Hummel Classroom Renovations). This project is the continuation of the Hummel Classroom Renovations project, which was completed in the summer of 2005, in which the remainder of the building (partial Second Floor and Third Floor) was renovated.
- Renovations to a portion of the Second Floor and the entire First Floor of the March Library were completed in the Hummel Learning Center at Episcopal High School. As it existed, the footprint of the First Floor is smaller than that of the floors above, creating a covered area around the perimeter of the building. The design called for this area to be enclosed, thereby increasing the usable square footage of the First Floor. The renovated First Floor includes high-end finishes, woodwork, and millwork throughout, creating a top-of-the-line high end library space. Additionally, the use of the first floor space will be re-oriented to move the circulation desk towards the front door, thus creating classroom and seminar rooms at the perimeter.
- Current Status: Construction Complete Winter 2010.
