The Museum Store Retail Space at The Washington National Cathedral Washington, D.C.

This project consisted of a newly constructed retail space in the underground bus depot area at the Washington National Cathedral. The underground parking garage, bus depot, and retail space were built in concert with one another utilizing the same project team. Under APM's Program Management, the multiple phases were to be completed and integrated at the same time, while coordinating with the same subcontractors under a compressed construction schedule. The design timeline was extended significantly to accommodate a lengthened value engineering period; however, APM successfully expedited the process and completed on schedule and budget.

- APM managed the installation of a wall-applied vinyl graphic that covers a wall to wall area. The logistics for installation were challenging, as the shape of the wall is a complicated irregular polygon on a sloped wall.
- APM organized the implementation of a state-of-the-art low voltage cable lighting systems that contoured the unique multiple architectural angles of the ceiling. The Museum Store has extensive high end mill work at the center desk and sales station.
- APM coordinated the extension of the base building CCTV security camera system to include coverage of the retail area.
